2. Membership may be terminated at the end of the current quarter only. Provided a four-week period of notice has been observed and notice has been submitted in writing in an informal manner.
3. The obligation to pay fees due and/or default fees remains unaffected by the notice of termination of membership.
4. In the case of a returned direct debit by the bank or savings bank due to declined payment, closing of the account etc., the member shall be liable for all charges incurred.
5. The membership ID card serves as proof of your BSG-membership. You must present it upon request to the trainer when taking part in training courses. The membership-number is at the same time the mandate reference.
